Developing the vision where pear trees could thrive in the West is the driving force started by Joseph Stewart that now bridges three centuries of agricultural history in the Rogue River Valley of Oregon. Many followed in his footsteps and together they built a fruit industry that still is recognized today as a worldclass location for premium pear fruit. Eden Valley Orchards is still host to the original trees planted 133 years ago. Continuing the legacy of pioneering new industries, Eden Valley Orchards now produces hard pear cider as a product of the original heritage trees.

THE PROPERTY TODAY

The Rogue Valley was recognized as the premier region in the world for commerical pears until the late 70's. As the quest for volume over quality diminished the region's vitality as a top producer of pears, the region reintroduced its agricultural prowness developing an equally historically relevant wine grape industry. Eden Valley Orchards again demonstrated vision in 1999, by expanding into premium winemaking and now combines both fruit products synergistically with the on-site production of award-winning wines and hard pear ciders.

Tim's grandfather Myron Root arrived in the Rogue Valley in 1908 at the beginning of the pear boom. For now four generations, the Root family has been a prominent leader throughout Southern Oregon's pear industry as a grower, packer, shipper ultimately creating a fruit processing company selling internationally. In 1999, the Roots acquired the Eden Valley Orchards property and have expanded and developed the property into a leading winery and cidery -- keeping it's history alive and relevant in the region.

Anne Root developed and managed the winery business since inception joinec by Ashley in 2001 as a mother - daughter team. The project required pioneering work on land use approvals in Jackson County and she developed the first wine tourism marketing promotion that introduced the region's wineries and connected to the region's industry awareness. Anne and Tim have three other children and four super cute miniature dachshunds that come to work every day.
